Meeting Minutes for May 18, 2009

Mike Manesiotis informed everyone that this meeting was being recorded; he called the meeting to order at 6:05 P.M.

Approval of Minutes: The April minutes were approved as they were written moved and seconded. Passed

Open Chair: recognition was given to Coach Sarah on how she has been instrumental on turning the softball program around and the condition of the facility.

Athletic Directors Report: Lew had reported on the outcome of Spring sports and how each team fared. He also announced the new head Girls Volleyball coach Garret Talarczyk. Ideas were discussed as to help promote attendance at various events. Also incorporating the Middle and elementary schools. Lew discussed the athletic account and asked for \$5000.00 to cover necessary expenses for the year. Discussion on this occurred and a motion was made to give the athletic department \$4800.00. This motion was seconded discussed and passed. Also noted was that the athletic web page is directly linked to the schools web page.

Coaches report: Girls softball reported the best season in four years and also will continue to work on field improvements. Asked that the boosters help with a flagpole. Football announce the begging of spring practice and the summer camp for kids @\$60.00 per child. Coach was asked to e-mail the details to Mike Manesiotis and he will list it on the web. Blake Bishop boys and girls track, reported great success recently at states. The boys 8x800 won states, Jack Felix won the 3200 and Spencer Wallace won the 1600

School Board member: Bob Arundell announced that we should expect a 5% budget cut to the schools effecting non-essential items such as athletics. He explained the funding of the system and stated that Beaufort County schools will not receive one cent from the state and that the state was looking to retract other funds that we have. Several questions asked about

this topic and it was determined that it may cause a reduction of \$20,000.00 to the athletic budget for the 2009-2010 year.

President's report: Mike Manesiotis reported that almost every goal for 2008-2009 had been accomplished. There had been over \$10,800.00 distributed to team accounts this year, over \$11,000.00 was paid towards scoreboards and stadium improvements, Over \$16,000.00 was paid off on the "field of Dreams" loan. \$9800.00 was paid for team shirts and uniforms. The total dollars raised and distributed this year was \$99,627,26. At the end of this year we should have \$5000.00 to carry over.

Baseball has raised over \$9000.00 and these funds will be put towards debt. Total "field of Dreams" debt is just over \$30,000.00

The Heritage foundation has donated \$7500.00 that was directly related to Barry Taylor and his efforts in running the commissary for the tournament.

There is about \$3000.00 of uncommitted funds available. Dave Martin suggested that these funds be put back into the system and used for promotional marketing to attract more students to games and events. The majority agreed.

Finally, Mike thanked all of his department heads especially Nancy Scanlin concessions chair for her tireless efforts and dedication.

Treasurer's report: Attached to the agenda.

Committee reports: Golf tournament chair Chuck Park reported on the tournament attended by 44 players. Some concern was expressed at to team "KENT" the winning team., a closer look at his score card was deemed necessary for next year. There is excess inventory of stadium seats and blankets that will be available in the concession stand.

Sports banquet chairs reported they are ready to go for the 26th. There is the opportunity to begin a pep band and they will perform several song at the beginning of the presentation..

Fundraising reported Mr. bob Rozak of the Island Rec Association for the work the Boosters did during the Hoop'n by the Beach tournament presented a check in the amount of \$1700.00.

Next meeting: August 17th. President Manesiotis said that there would be an executive board meeting in June to discuss plans and follow up on projects.
