

Dave Greenberg--Head varsity coach

Dave Greenberg took over as head Varsity Girls basketball coach of the rebuilding Hilton Head High School team six years ago following a storied 22 year career in Maryland and 3 years as a volunteer assistant coach at Hilton Head Prep. His teams in Maryland won what is still a Maryland public school state record 6 State championships as well as 8 Regional championships and 15 County championships. More importantly, of the 70 graduates from his programs, nearly 30 were offered basketball scholarship money totaling over \$750,000. Eleven of his graduates have been captains of their college teams, three have been coaches in college, and one played in the womens professional league. Three of his former assistant coaches are currently head coaches in high schools in Maryland and South Carolina. He left Maryland as the second winningest girls basketball coach in the state with an overall record of 425-113. He now has a total of 487 wins in his 28 year career as a head coach. The Hilton Head girls have made the playoffs each of the last five years and two years ago won the Regional championship for the first time since 1994 and second time ever.

Dave coordinated and worked basketball camps for over 25 years. Having served for three years as President of the Maryland Womens Basketball Coaches Association, he was elected to the Howard County Maryland Womens Athletics Hall of Fame a few years back. Coach Greenberg has been selected as Coach of the Year in girls basketball numerous times by a variety of news organizations and has also coached football (over 25 years), girls soccer (2 years—both State championships), and baseball (5 years).
